MISSION

BCHD RYAN WHITE PROGRAM

- Improve the quality of life for people living with HIV/AIDS and their families in Baltimore City and surrounding counties
- Provide comprehensive guidance to Ryan White providers and the Baltimore Planning Council to ensure compliance with Ryan White legislations and standards of care

Objective

- Demonstrate FY 2017 client level data for priority setting and resource allocation



Total Consumers Served by Ryan White N = 12,486

- Received any Ryan White defined service regardless of payer

- Federal Poverty Level < 500%
 - **Exclusions**
 - consumers with an unconfirmed HIV Diagnosis
 - consumers with an HIV Status of Indeterminate & < 2 years of age
 - consumers with an FPL > 500%

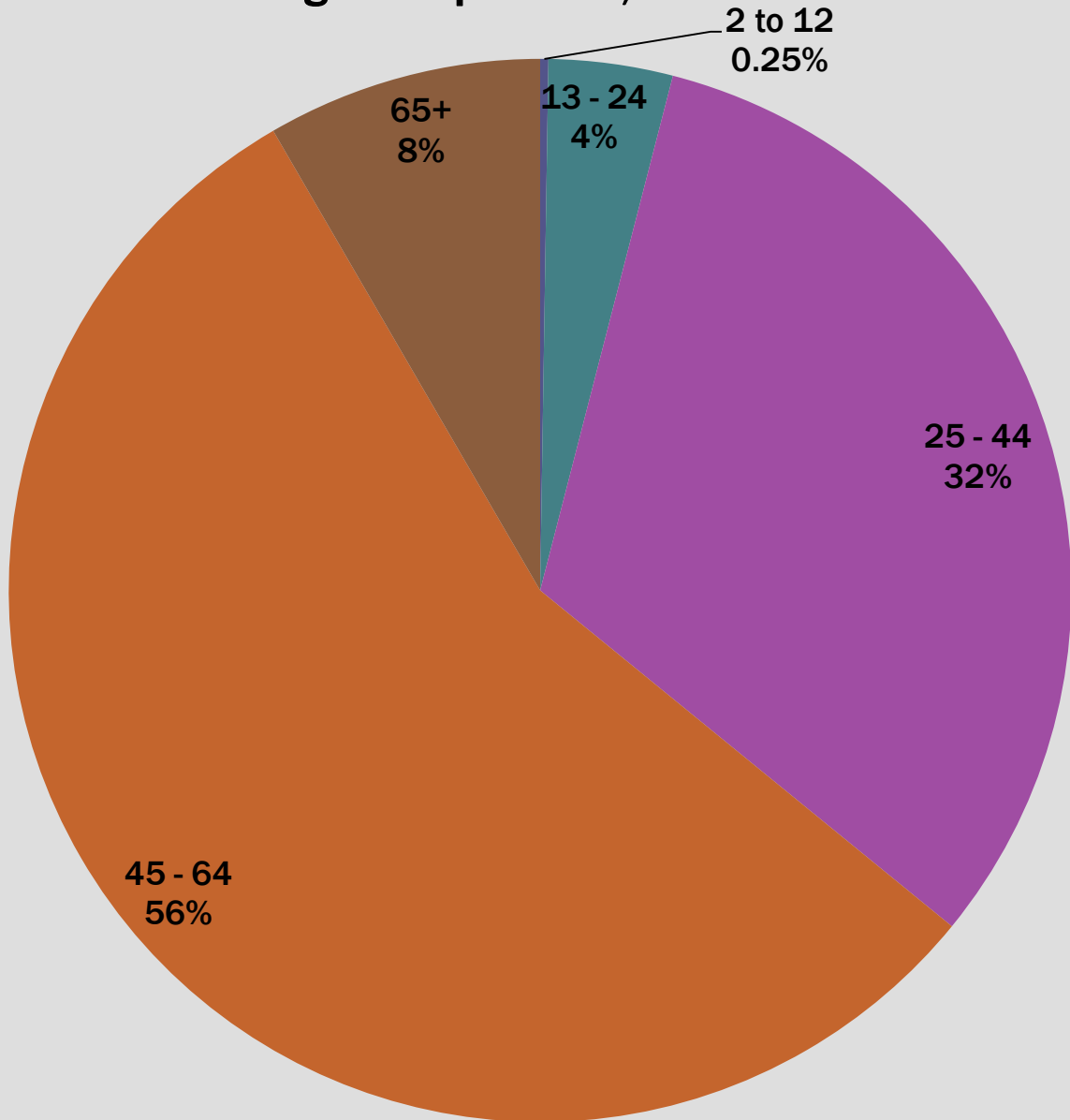
At a glance, who are the Ryan White consumers in the Baltimore Eligible Metropolitan Area (EMA)?

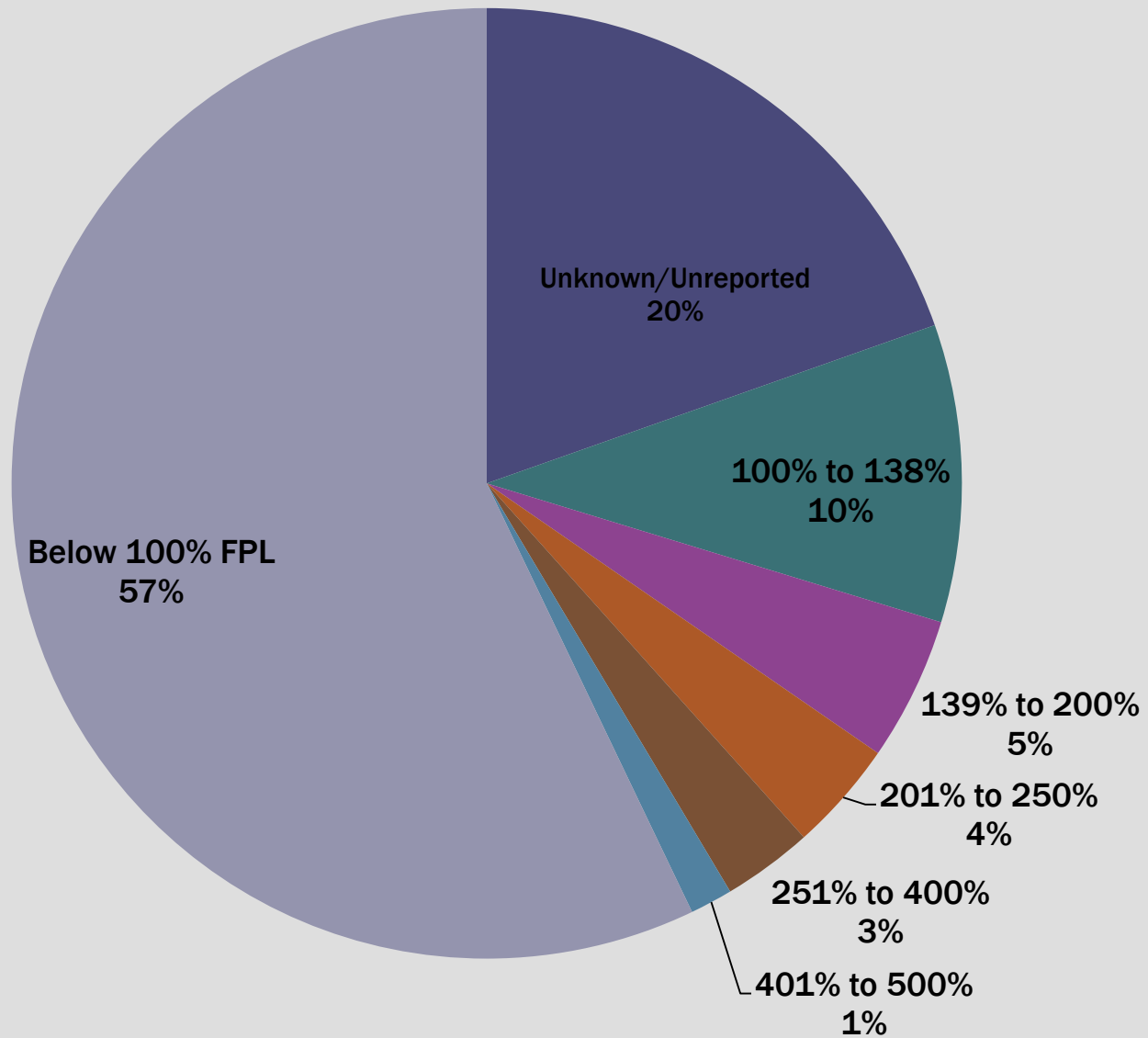
- **61% Males**

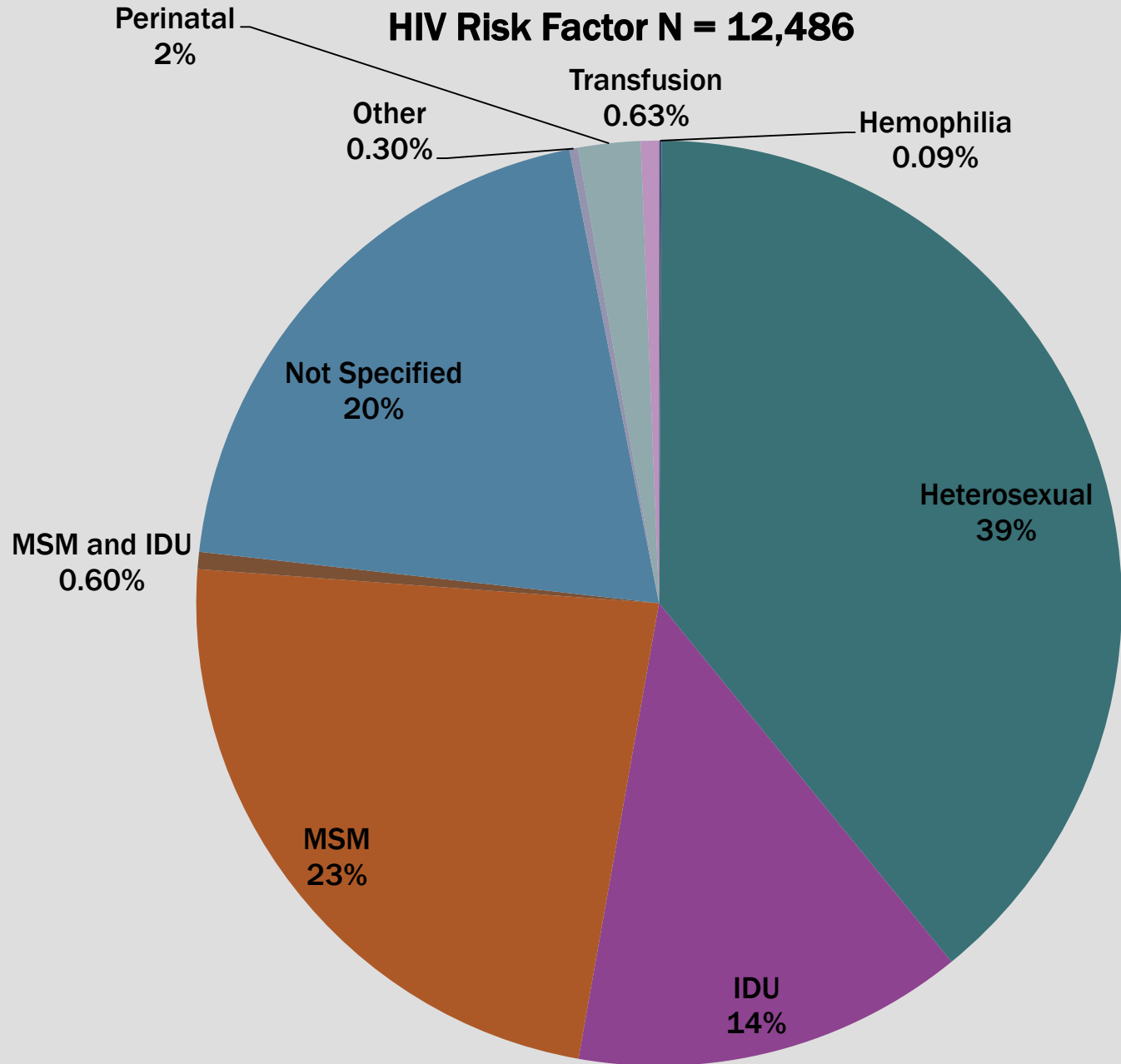

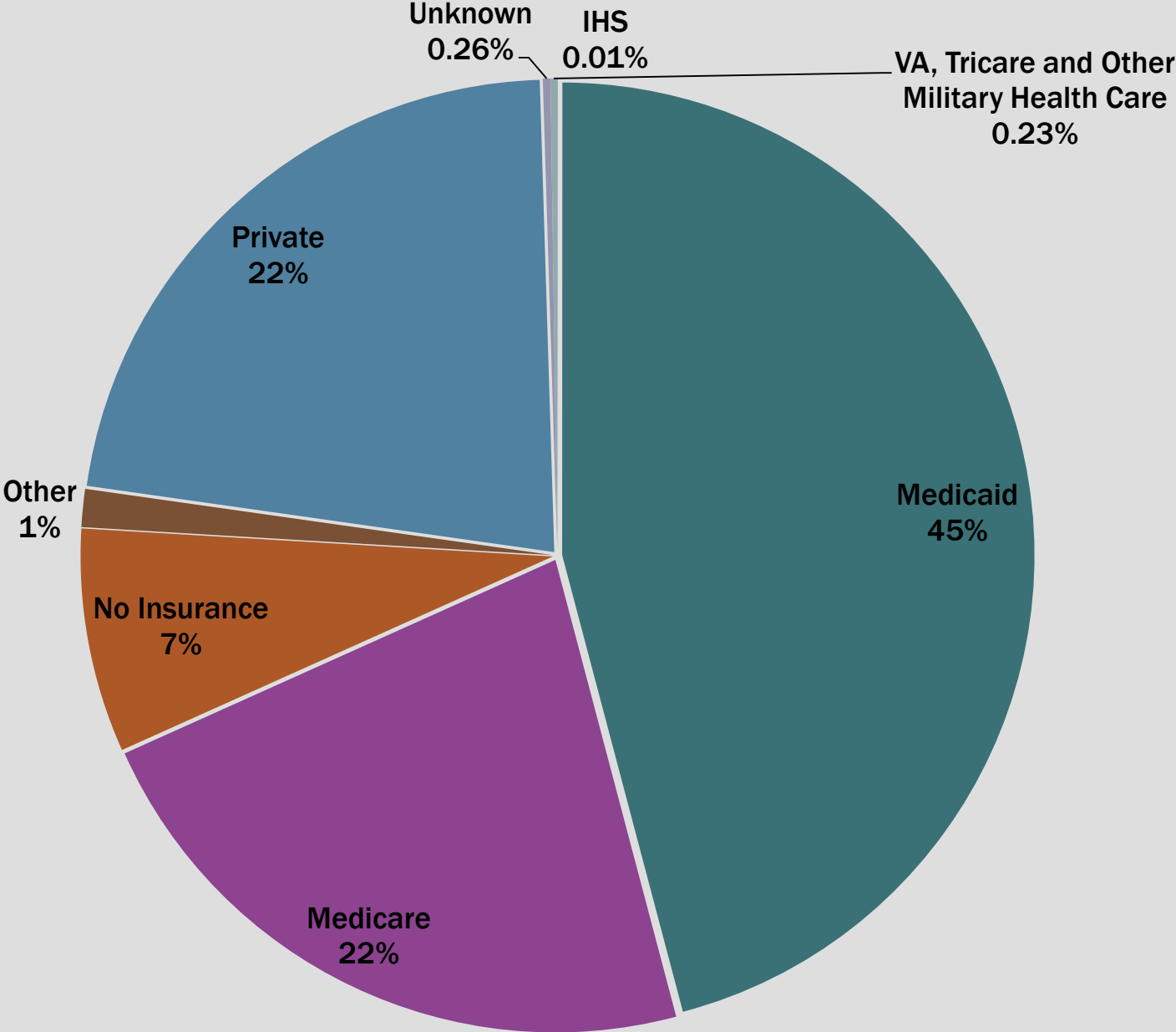
Federal Poverty Level N=12,486



HIV Risk Factor N = 12,486

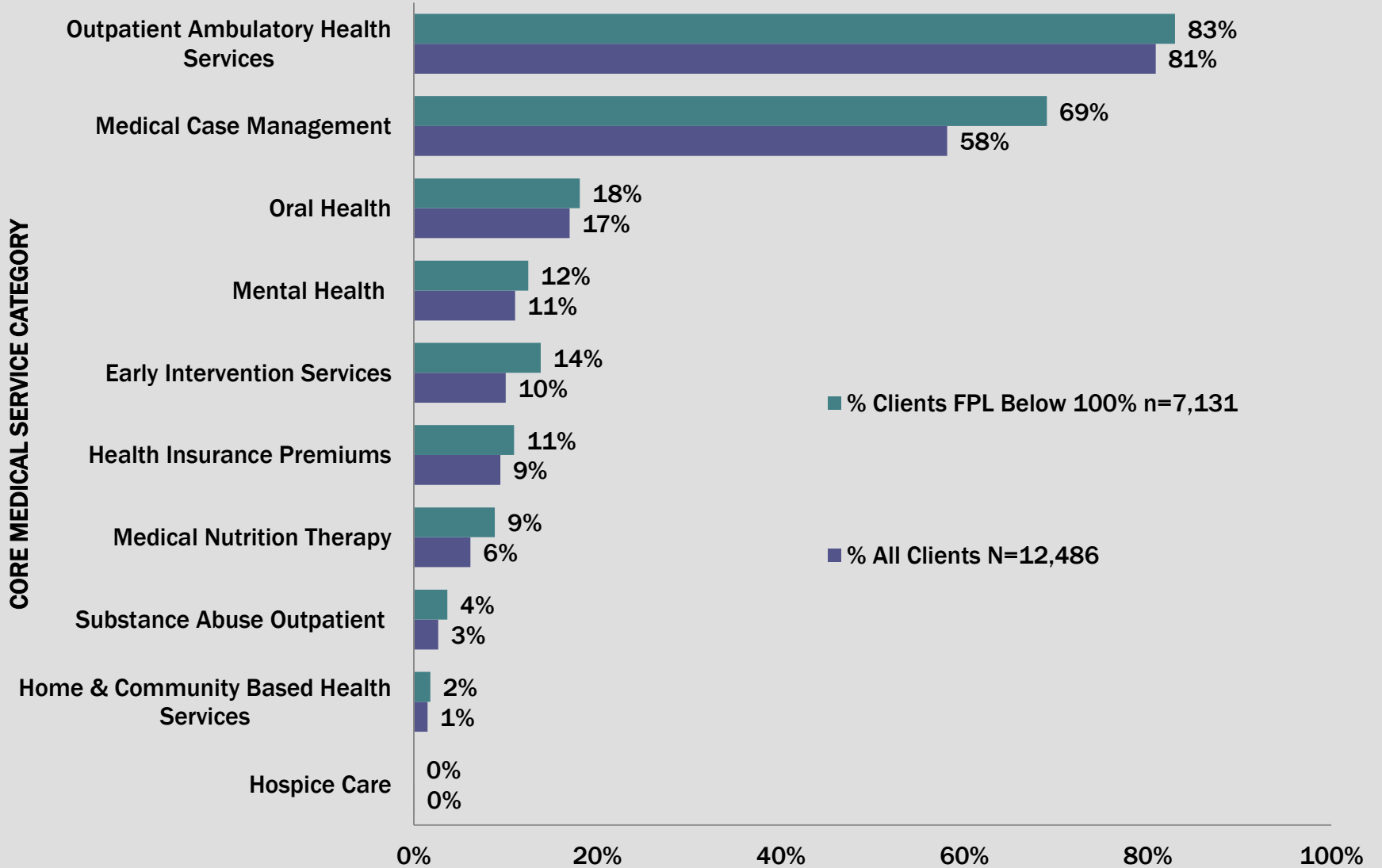


Insurance Status N = 12,486

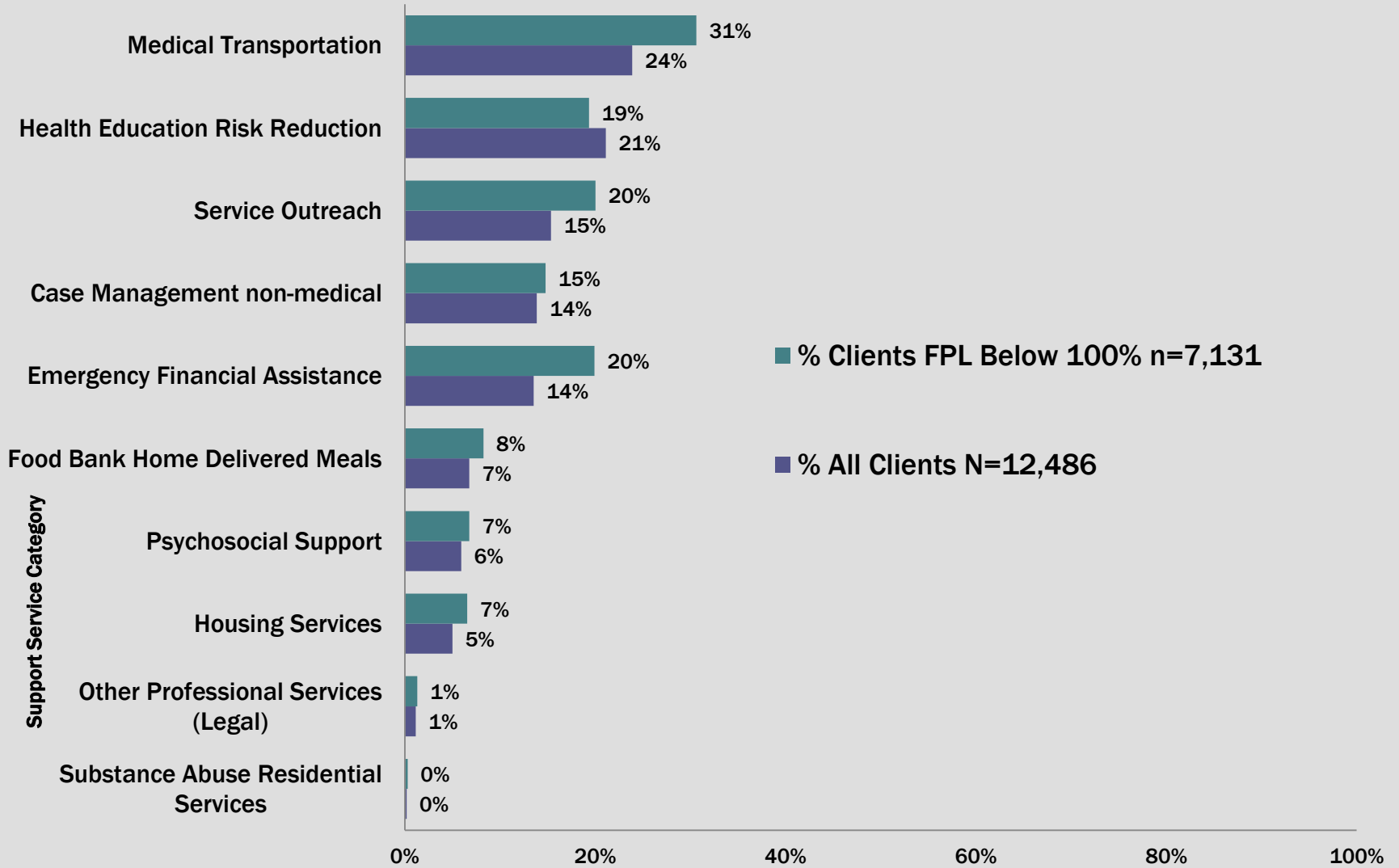

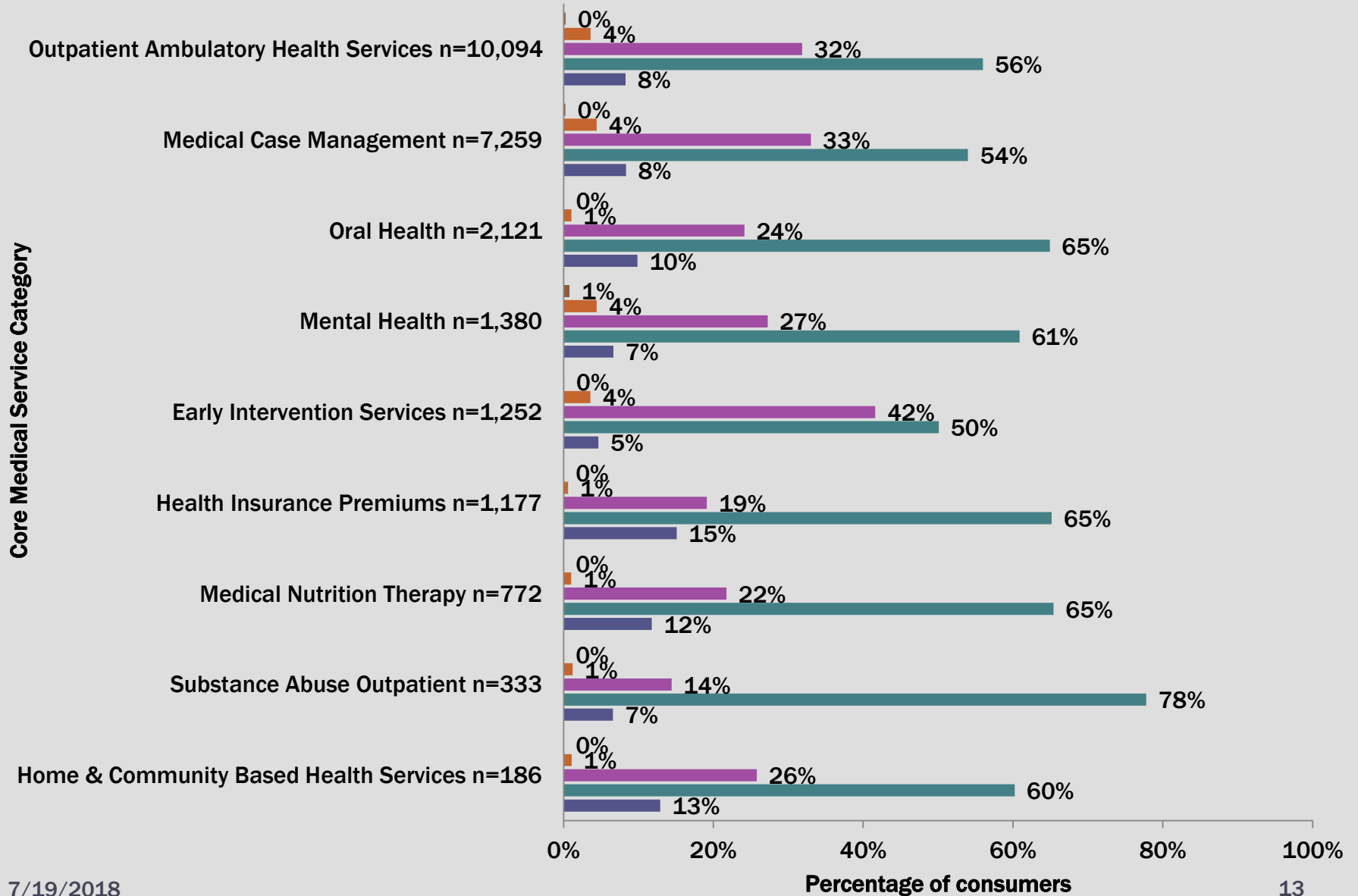

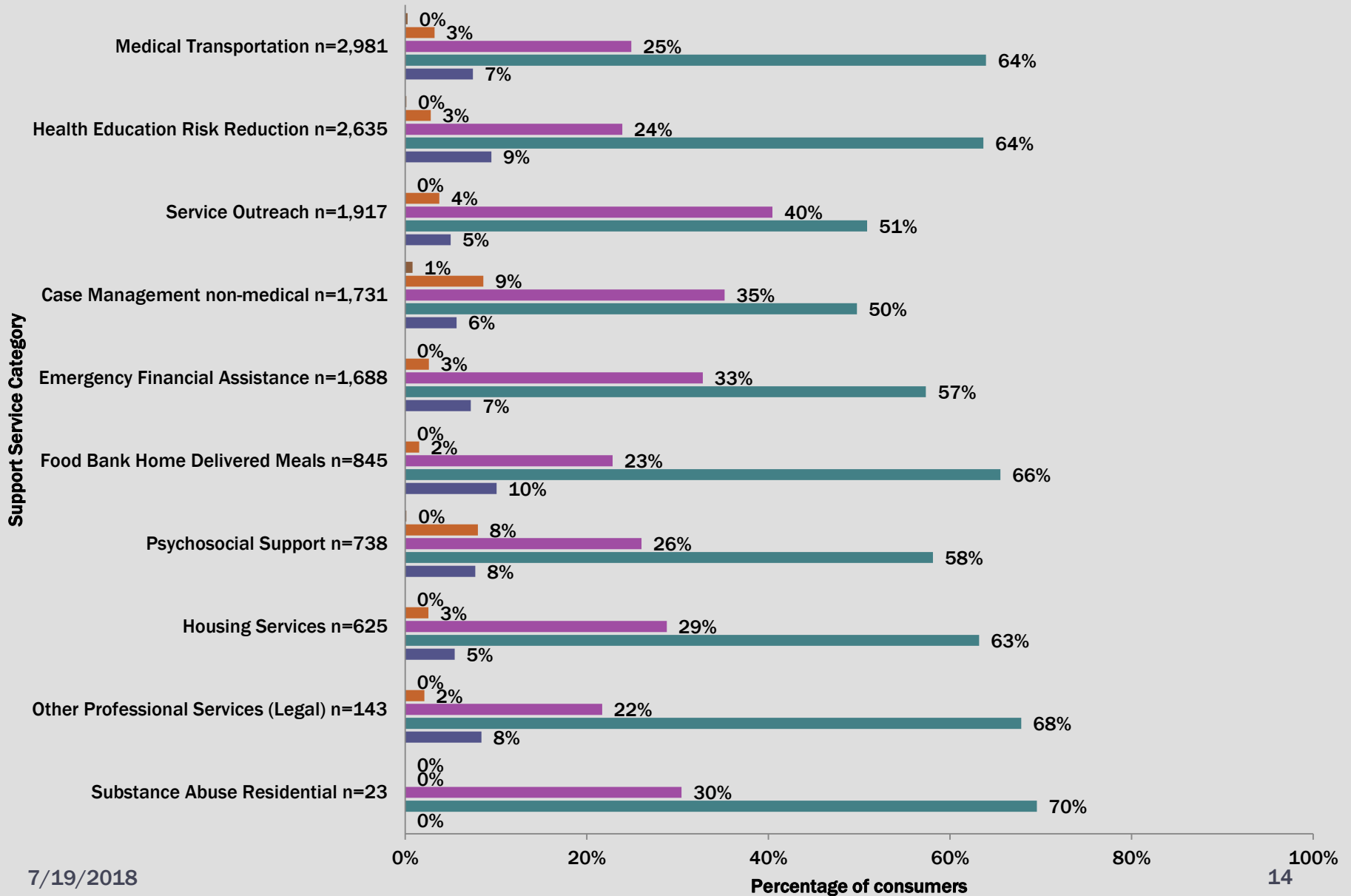
Core Medical Services by Age Group

■ 2 to 12 ■ 13 to 24 ■ 25 to 44 ■ 45 to 64 ■ 65+



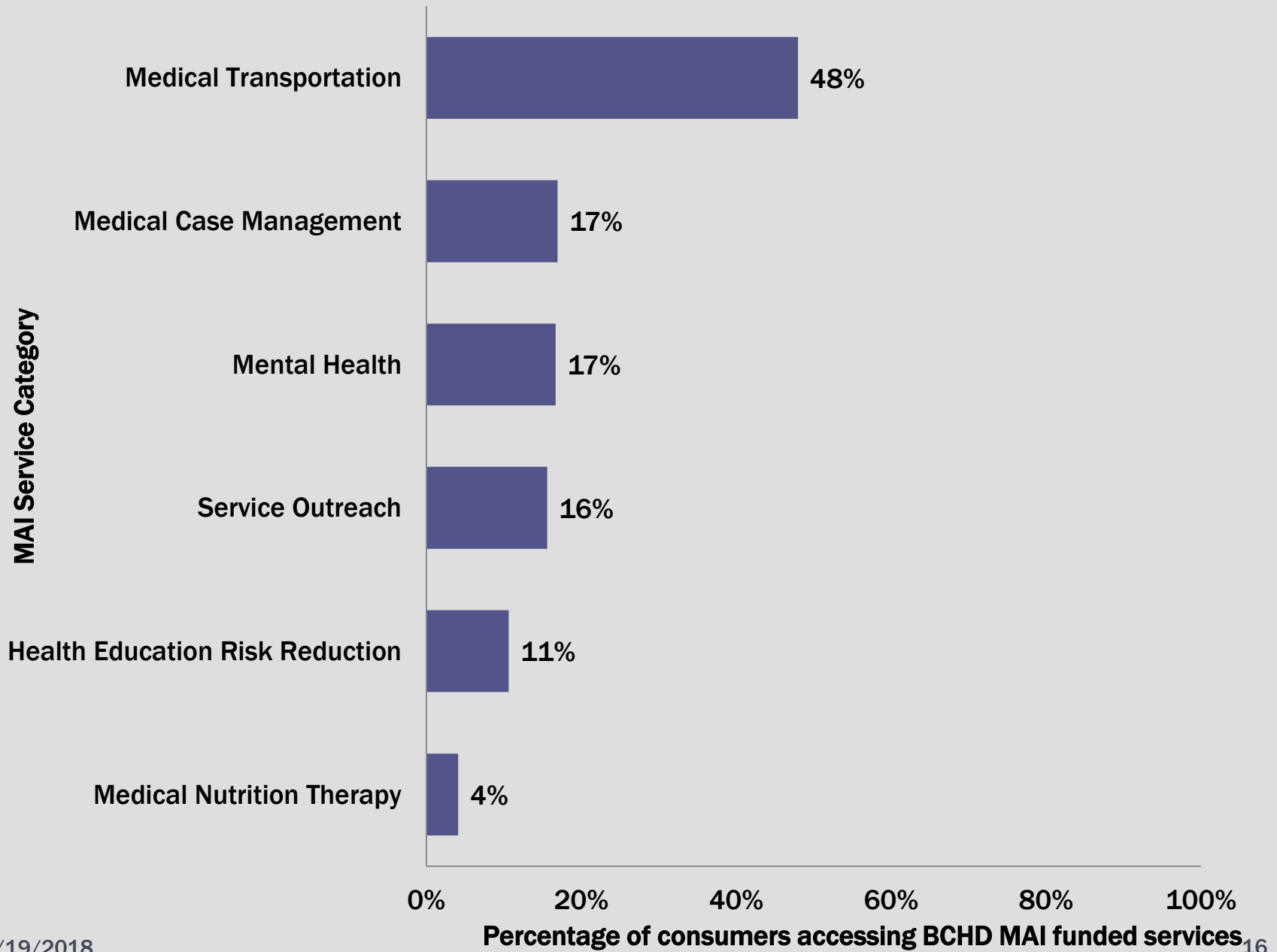
Support Services by Age Group

Retention in HIV Medical Care

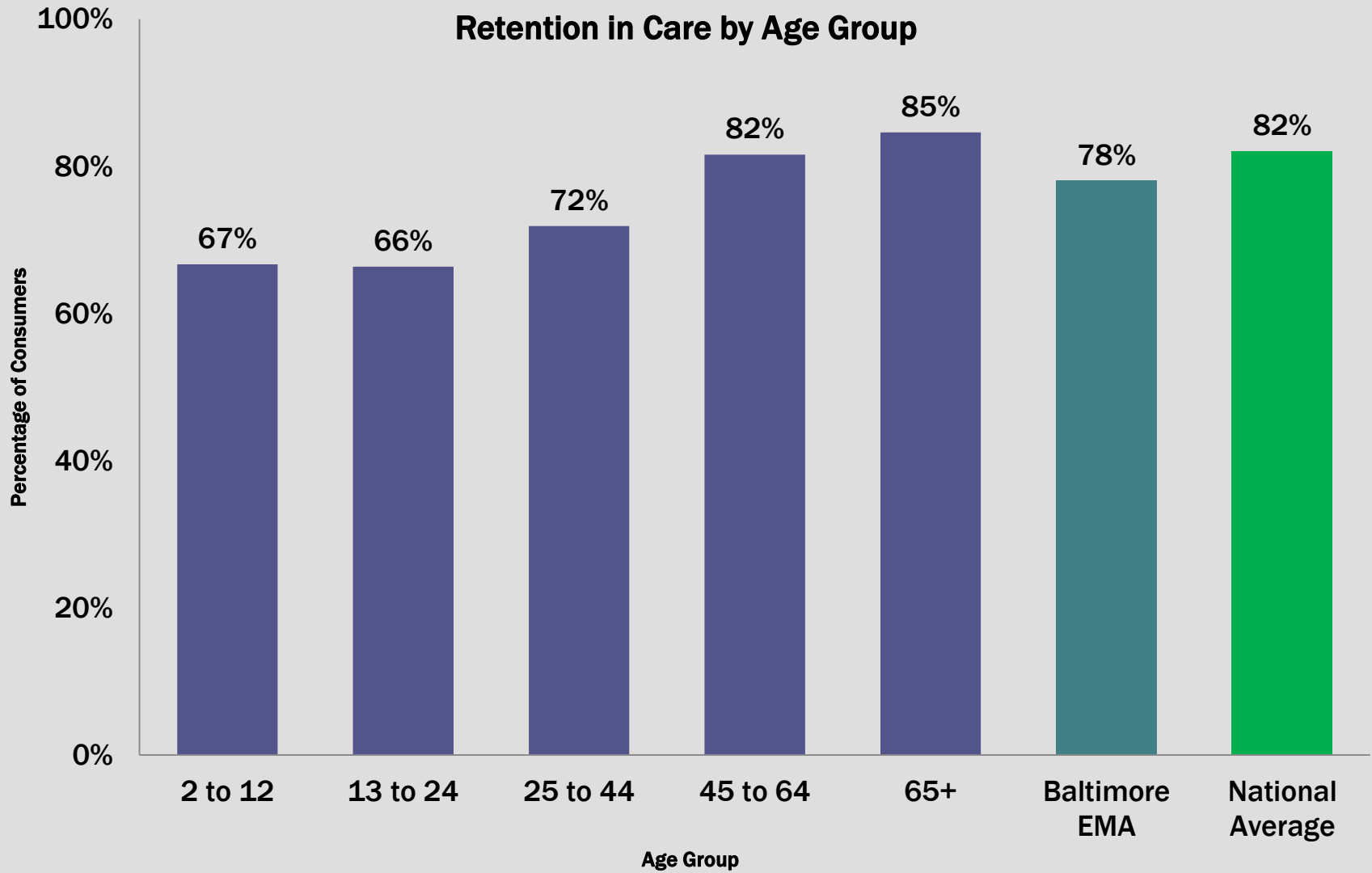

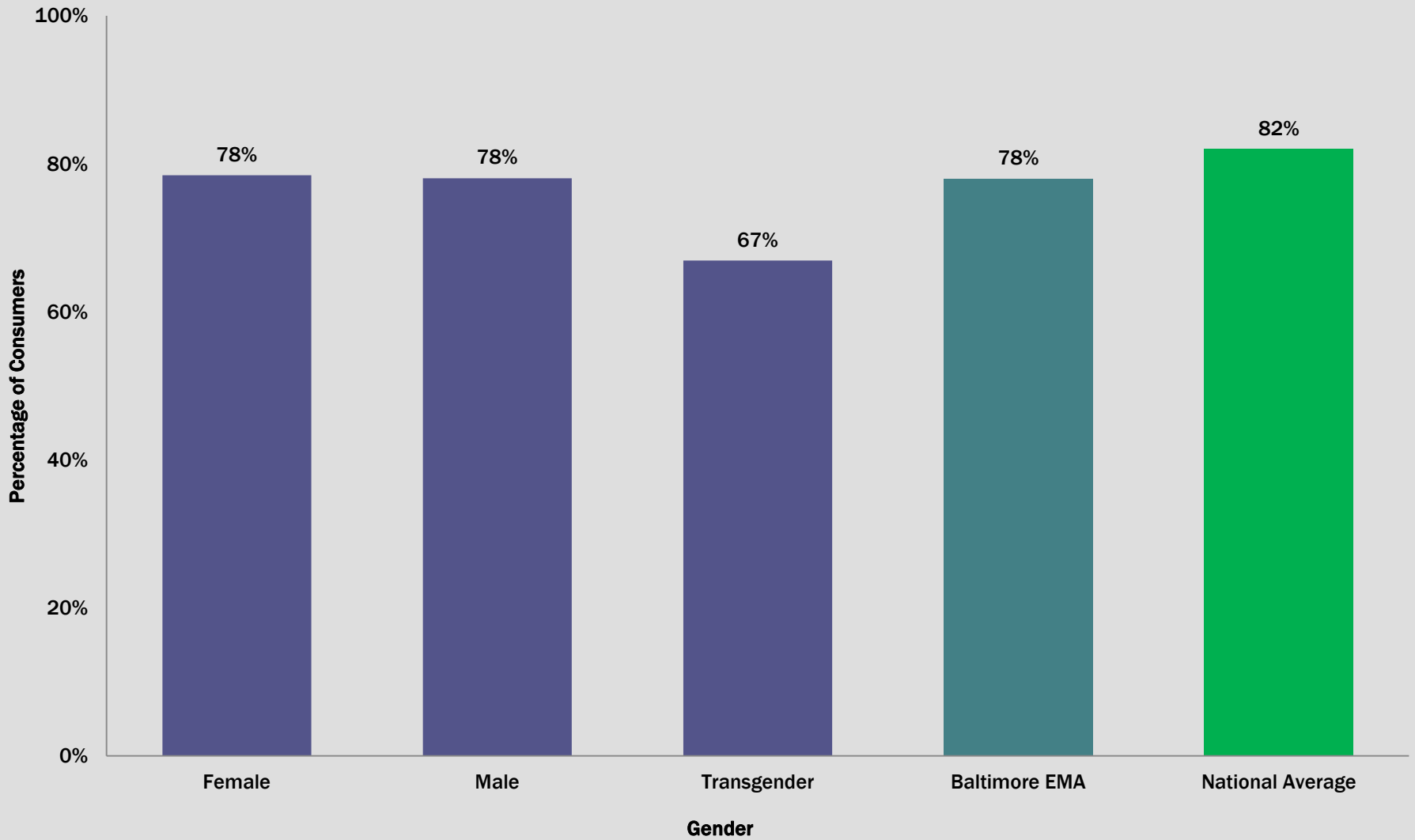

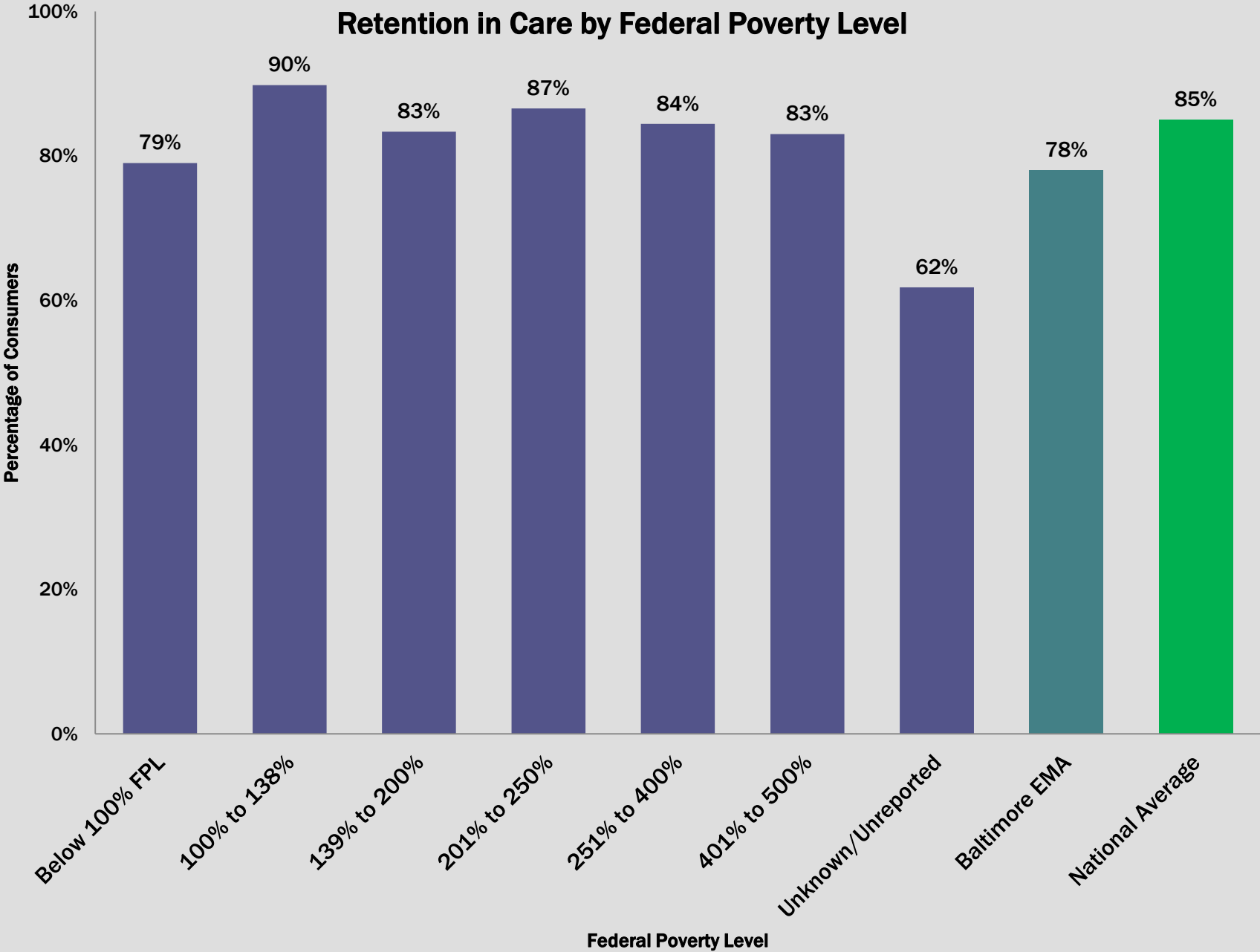
Retention in Care by Age Group

VIRAL LOAD SUPPRESSION

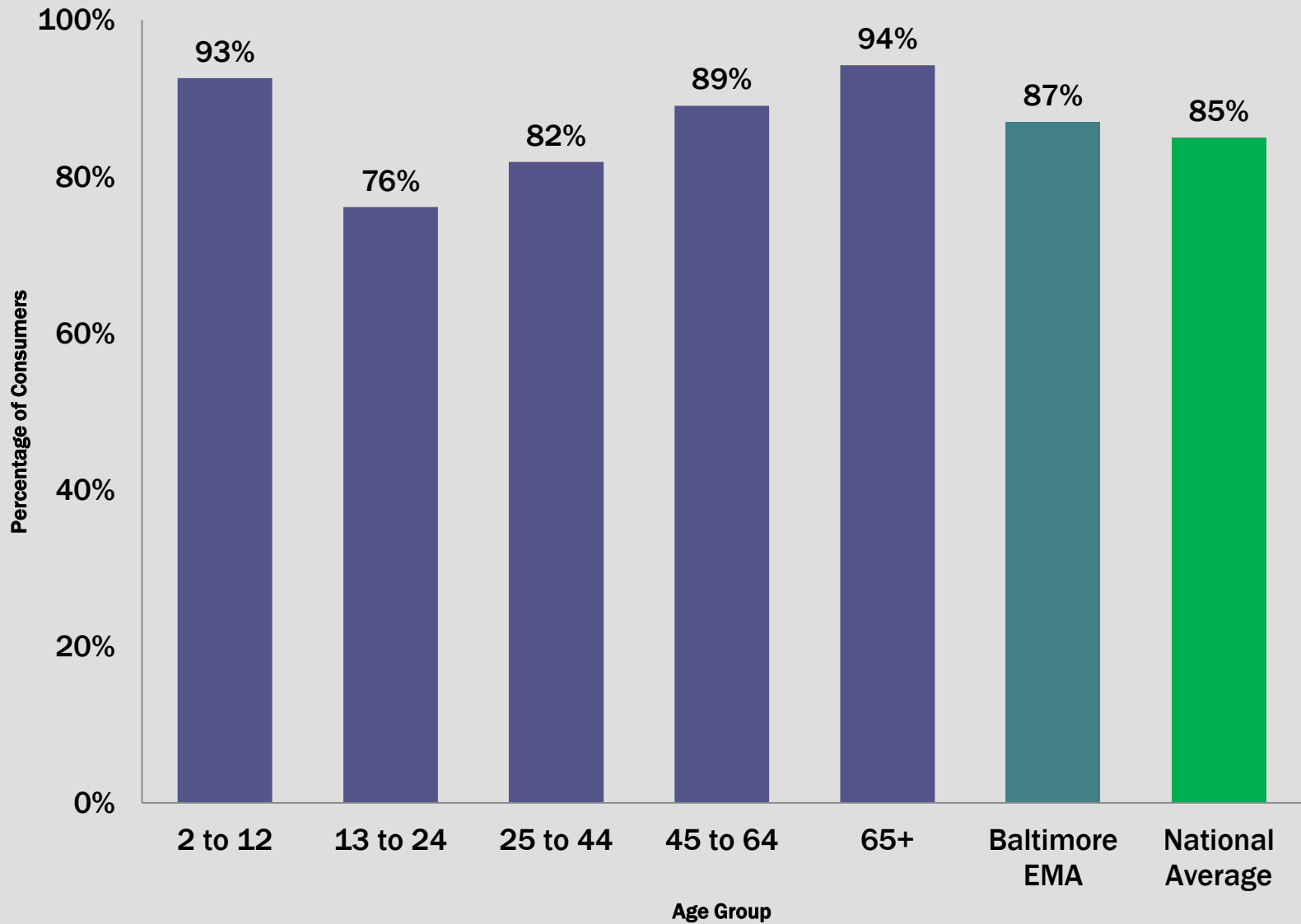
Viral Load Suppression

Viral suppression is calculated among PLWH who had at least 1 OAHS and at least 1 viral load during the measurement year. Viral suppression is defined as a most recent viral load test result <200 copies/mL.

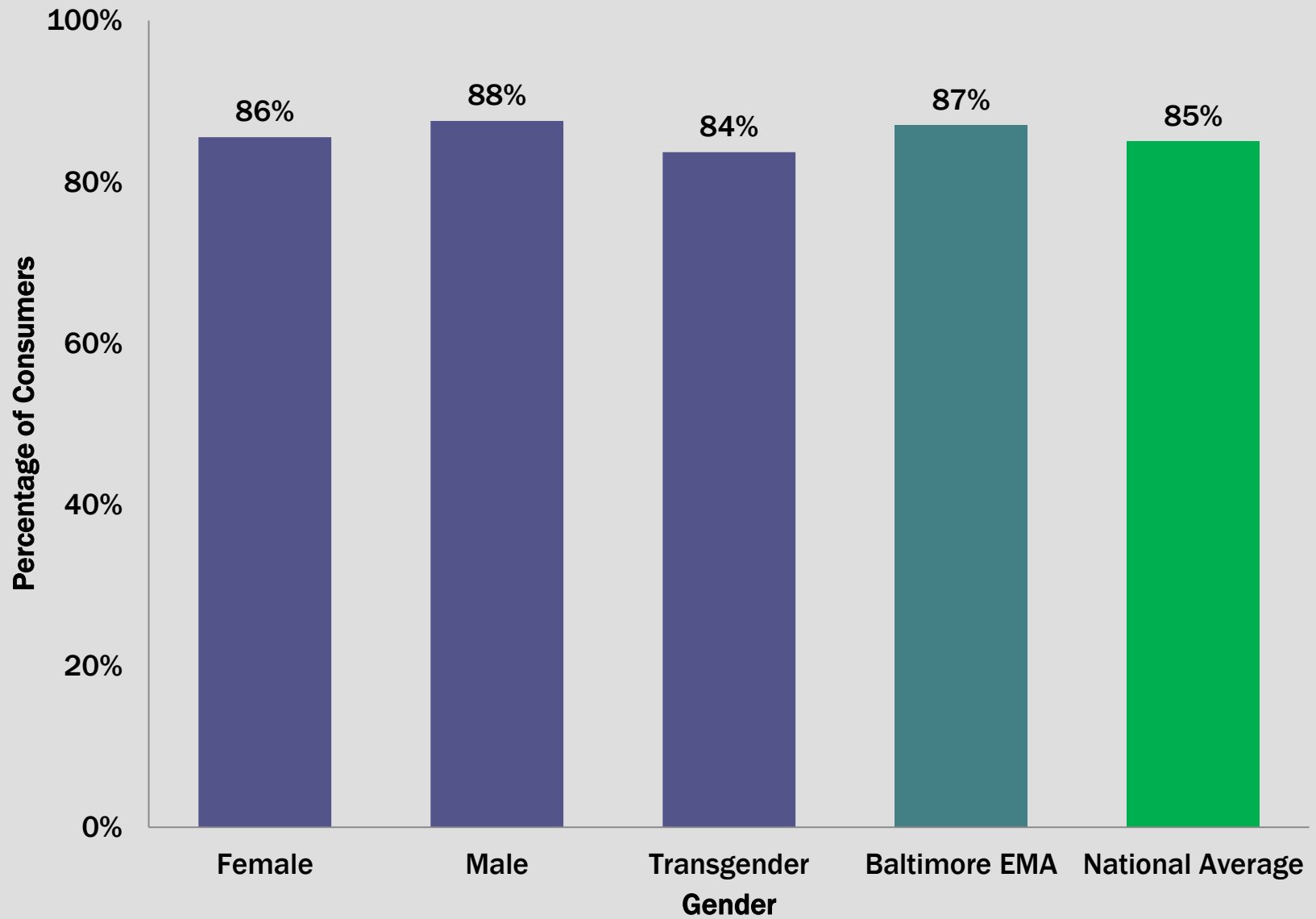

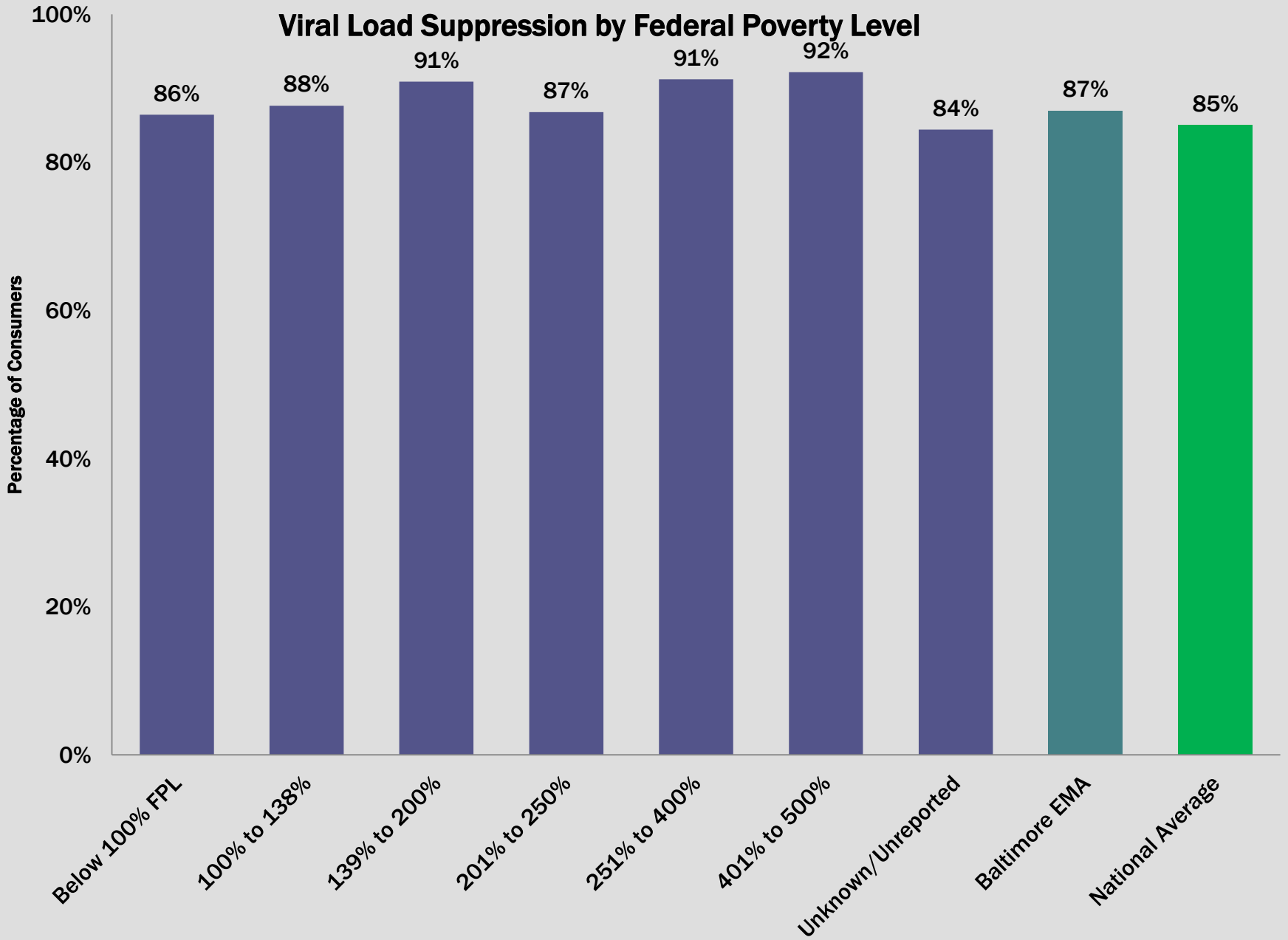
Viral Load Suppression by Age Group



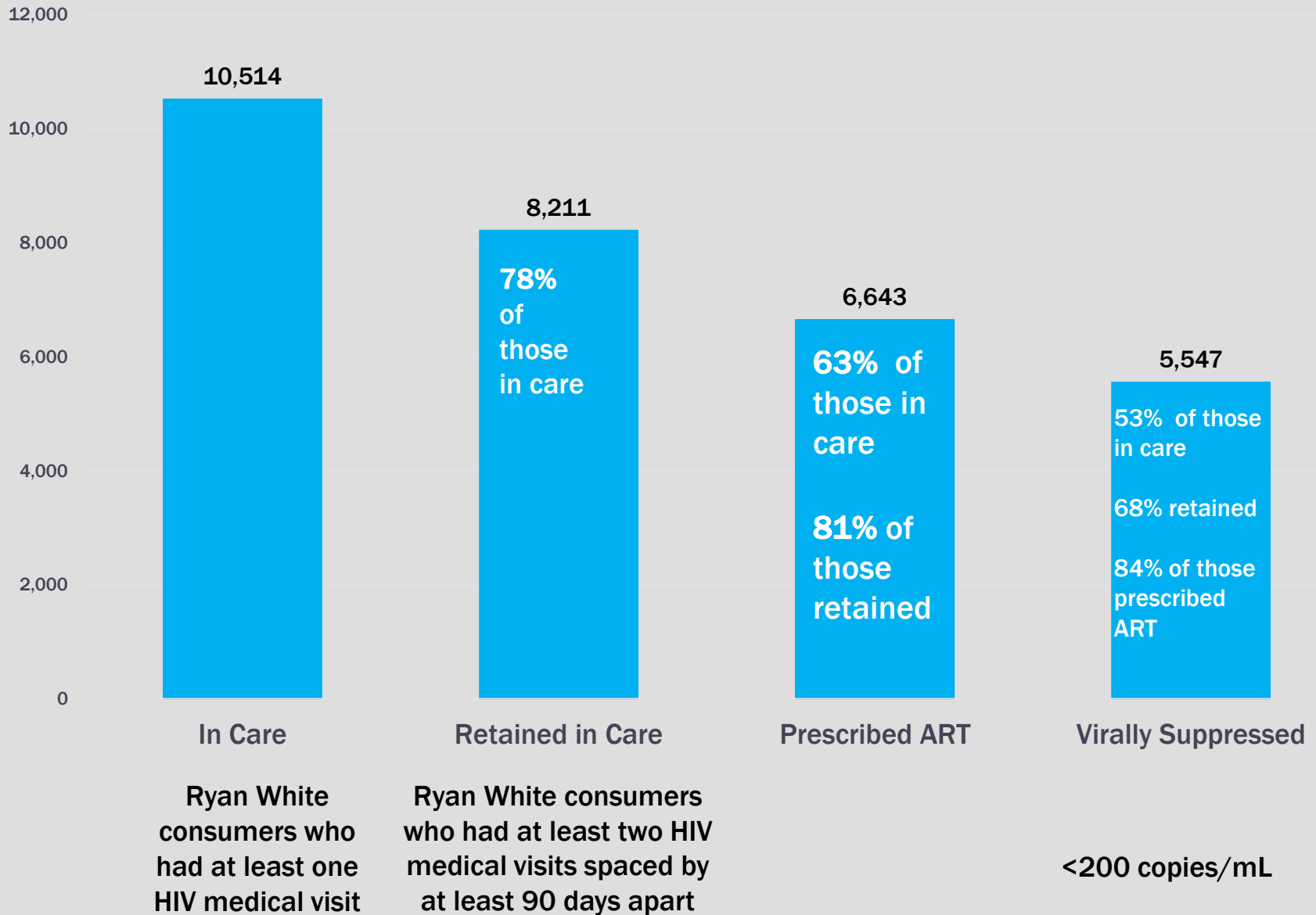
Viral Load Suppression by Gender
