



1. Describe the services you offer, and the number of clients you service, utilization of your services, etc.

With Ryan White funding Moveable Feast provides 1 core medical service and 2 support services:

- Medical Nutritional Therapy (MNT)
- Home-delivered meals
- Medical transportation

Food Bank/ home delivered meals:

EMA – 209 clients with 102,941 meals and 4445 units of supplements

MAI – 53 clients with 28,266 meals and 715 units of supplements

STSC – 89 clients with 44,463 meals and 1828 units of supplements

TOTAL CLIENTS: 351 TOTAL MEALS: 175,670 TOTAL SUPPLEMENTS: 6988

WAITING LIST (as of May 31): EMA: 117 STSC: 5 = 122

Medical Nutrition Therapy (MNT):

EMA – 154 clients with 799 units of service (BIAs, weight management, assessments)

MAI – 87 clients with 403 units of service (BIAs, weight management, assessments)

STSC – 101 clients with 437 units of service (BIAs, weight management, assessments)

2. What trends are you seeing among your client base and in your services?
 - New referrals are HIV Stage 3, and seriously ill; viral loads in the millions, T cell counts in single digits; very sick individuals;
 - AA male, 42, 4 dependent children; T cell count of 4
 - Those in care seem well maintained: keeping weight on/gaining weight; med compliant; keeping doctor visits; lower use of ER; fewer OI's;
 - Younger clients: early 20's: born with HIV.

3. Aside from Ryan White, what other funding streams are available to your organization for the services you provide?
 - Moveable Feast receives funding from corporations, foundations, events, UWCM, HOPWA, State of Maryland.
 - These funding streams also help Moveable Feast to provide other basic necessities for our clients: microwaves, electric can openers, blenders, storage containers, freezer bags, etc.

4. How has the implementation of the Affordable Care Act impacted the services you provide, or how do you anticipate it will impact your services in the future?
 - The impact is yet to be determined for support services and MNT

5. Is your organization taking any unique/innovative approaches to client services with the Ryan White funding you receive?
 - Home visits allow us to assess a client in his/her home surrounding. We can other needs of the client as well as conduct BIA study, personalized education, etc.
 - A research "white paper", in partnership with JHMI and the Bloomberg School of Public Health, will also us to identify the relationship between eating well and the health maintenance of seriously ill individuals.
